## Notes

- 1 "Contribution" means a pledge that has been converted into a fully signed financial contribution agreement between the investor and CEPI and that contributions have been made to CEPI as specified by the terms of the agreement.
- 2 "Pledge" means a publicly announced amount of funding that is pledged to CEPI.
- 3 Contributions received for CEPI 1.0 use exchange rate on the date funds are received. Contributions pledged for CEPI 1.0 but not yet received use CEPI Budget 2022 exchange rates. Contributions pledged for CEPI 2.0 but not yet received use pledge date exchange rates.
- 4 Includes pledges made through at the Global Pandemic Preparedness Summit on 07 – 08 March 2022.
- 5 Includes EUR 5M contribution in 2021 received via the International Finance Facility for Immunisations (IFFIm)
- 6 Includes contributions of NOK 600M frontloaded in 2019 through IFFIm, and NOK 2B frontloaded through IFFIm for COVID-19 in 2020.
- 7 Pledge made in May 2020 for payment to CEPI via IFFIm; effectuating the pledge through IFFIm is ongoing.
